

CODE OF CONDUCT

Diplomatic Conduct and Professionalism

- All delegates must comply with the instructions provided by organizing committee members.
- Before the start of SIISMUN 2026, all Participants must sign the undertaking that is the Liability Release Form they will abide by this Code of Conduct for the duration of SIISMUN 2026.
- Delegates must carry their school ID on both the days of the conference. ● Delegates are required to wear their ID cards, which are provided to them at the time of registration.
- Delegates must remain within designated MUN areas (committee rooms, common areas, cafeteria, etc.) during the conference.
- All delegates must treat others—delegates, chairs, organizers, and staff—with respect, dignity, and professionalism at all times.
- Discrimination or harassment on the basis of race, gender, nationality, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or any other identity will not be tolerated.
- Delegates must act with diplomacy, maintaining formal and constructive dialogue during all committee sessions.

- Personal attacks, offensive language, or aggressive behaviour are strictly prohibited.
- The use of alcohol, drugs, or any illegal substances during the conference is strictly prohibited.
- Unruly or inappropriate behaviour outside committee sessions that affects the reputation of the MUN may also result in disciplinary action.

DELEGATE ATTIRE

- Delegates are required to follow the dress code prescribed by SIISMUN. ● All delegates need to wear business formals on Day 1 and traditional attire on the 2nd day of the conference.
- Formal shirts with full sleeves and formal pants are permitted. Suits, blazers and ties are optional but suggested. Jeans and shorts are **NOT PERMITTED**. ● Crop tops, sheer blouses, spaghetti tops are NOT allowed. Sleeveless formal tops, if worn, must be accompanied by a blazer. If worn, waistcoats must be accompanied by a shirt.

Punctuality and Participation

- Delegates must attend all committee sessions on time. Repeated tardiness or absence without valid reason may result in disqualification.
- Roll calls will be taken at the beginning of each session.

Delegates are expected to

- Come well-prepared, having researched their country's position.
- Actively participate in debates, draft resolutions, and caucuses.

Plagiarism and Intellectual Integrity

- All position papers, speeches, and resolutions must be the original work of the delegate or delegation.
- Plagiarism or copying from other delegates' work will lead to sanctions or disqualification.

Use of Technology

Gadgets & Electronic Devices

Permitted Use

Delegates may use laptops, tablets, or phones only for:

- Research relevant to committee discussions, Drafting working papers or resolutions, Communicating with fellow delegates (as allowed by the Chair). ● Any other usage (social media, entertainment, unrelated texting) is strictly prohibited during committee hours.
- Recording or photographing debates or other delegates without explicit permission is not allowed.
- Phones should be kept on silent mode or turned off during formal sessions.
- Misuse (gaming, messaging unrelated to MUN, disruptive behaviour) is strictly forbidden.
- The use of the internet will only be allowed with the permission of the executive board.

Role of the Chair

- The Chair's decisions are final during committee proceedings.
- Delegates must follow the rules of procedure as outlined by the MUN and enforced by the Chair.

Consequences for Misconduct

- Warnings may be issued for minor offenses.
- Repeated or serious violations may result in:
 - Expulsion from the committee or conference,
 - Disqualification from awards,
- Any violations of the Code of Conduct will be reported to the faculty advisor and the delegate will not be allowed to attend further committee sessions.
- All delegates will be subject to frisking and any material that is deemed to be not allowed in school premises will be confiscated.

If any delegate does not abide by the above rules, the secretariat has the right to suspend the delegate from the conference.
